4-...et les activités langagières mises en oeuvre

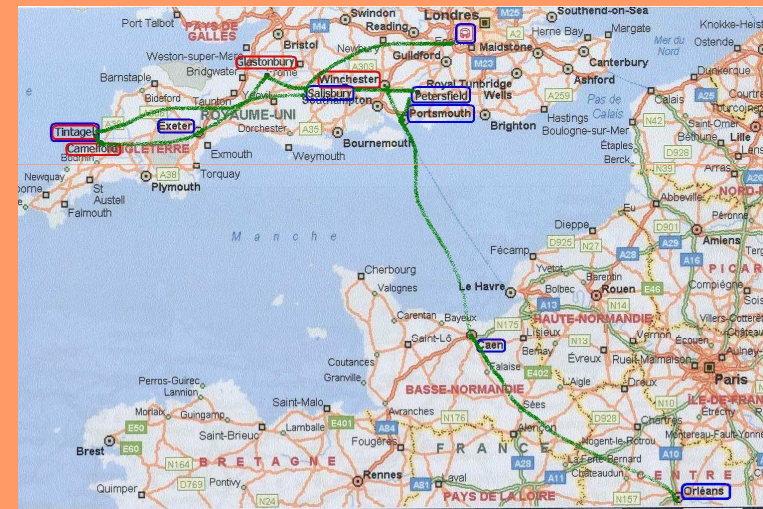
- EO: je peux faire un bref exposé quand j'ai pu me préparer

Mise en œuvre - 1

- **Monday 02.12.07**
- Departure early in the morning by bus from your school to Caen- Ouistréham. Boarding a Brittany Ferries ship at 9:00 am for the crossing of the Channel. Landing at Portsmouth at 1:45 pm and departure by bus thereafter to Winchester: Visit of the medieval room, where King's Arthur Round Table stands. Discovery of the city. Transfer by bus to Exeter at the end of the afternoon. Arrival at the youth-hostel thereafter.
- **Tuesday 02.13.07**
- Departure to the little village of Tintagel, which is situated on the North of Cornwall. Visit of the village and of the castle. Pack lunch provided by the Youth Hostel. Visit of King's Arthur Hall; a building constructed in the 1930's by a wealthy lover of the Arthurian legend. Departure in the afternoon to Camelford. It is said to be the famous town of Camelot. Visit of the city. You'll be back to Exeter by bus at the end of the afternoon.
- **Wednesday 02.14.07**
- Departure to Glastonbury. Walk up to The Tor and visit of the Glastonbury Abbey. Pack lunch provided by the Youth Hostel. Sports in the afternoon! Rugby matches at Winchester Rugby football club. Dinner at the club house offered by WRFC. Night spent at Salisbury Youth Hostel.
- **Thursday 02.15.07**
- Departure to Stonehenge, the oldest monument in England. Visit of the site. Pack lunch provided by the Youth Hostel. Departure by bus at the beginning of the afternoon to Twickenham. Visit of the stadium and of the museum. Night spent at Salisbury Youth Hostel.
- **Friday 02.16.07**
- Discovery of Salisbury: the city, the cathedral. Morning free time for shopping. Pack lunch provided by the Youth hostel. Departure at the beginning of the afternoon to Petersfield. Rugby matches against the colts of the Petersfield RC. Dinner at the clubhouse provided by PRFC.
- You shall board a Brittany Ferries ship at 11:15 for the crossing of the Channel.
- **Saturday 02.17.07**
- Breakfast aboard the ship. Landing at Caen-Ouistréham at 7:00 am. Following by the journey back to your school by bus.

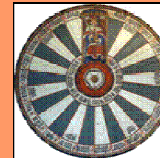
Mise en œuvre - 3

King Arthur's places

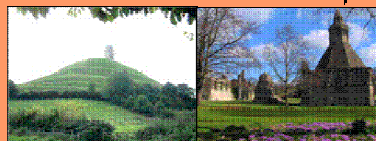


Tintagel is a little village that is located north of Cornwall, and where we are going to visit the castle where Arthur was born.
